About this course

The Professional Scrum Product Owner™ (PSPO) is a cutting-edge, two-day course for Product Owners, Agile product managers and anyone responsible for a software product's success in the market.

The breadth of the product owner's responsibilities in delivering a successful product will become clearer, and metrics are identified to track the creation of value and the successful delivery of the product to the marketplace. In this course, students will develop and solidify their knowledge of being a product owner through instruction, real-life cases and discussion with teams of classmates.

- Product managers and Scrum product owners responsible for the delivery of a product

- Strategy managers responsible for the overarching direction of a product or product family

- Have studied the Scrum Guide (required)
- Have taken the Scrum Open (free online assessment)
- Have taken the Professional Scrum Foundations course
- Have experience on or exposure to a Scrum team
- Possess a general understanding of requirements and requirements decomposition
- Have been on or closely involved with a project that builds or enhances a product
