About this course

During the Scaled Professional Scrum™ (SPS) course, students will simulate a large software development project using the Nexus™ framework. The course is delivered using an end-to-end case study where students work together to organize and simulate a scaled software development project. Throughout the two-day session, students will be introduced to more than 50 practices that can be used to help reduce complexity and dependencies at scale.

The SPS provides students with an understanding of how to launch, structure, staff and manage a large Agile project using Scrum. Students will learn the infrastructure, tools and practices needed to successfully scale Scrum to maximize the value of their software development initiative.

By taking a hands-on approach, students are fully engaged in the learning process where they see firsthand the challenges in large scale development initiative — and solutions for getting the work back on track. They will leave the course with techniques to detect irregularities and how to address them appropriately.

Who should attend

The SPS course is recommended for development leads, development managers, project/program managers and anyone else involved in coaching, formulating, participating in or managing scaled product development projects using Agile and Scrum.
